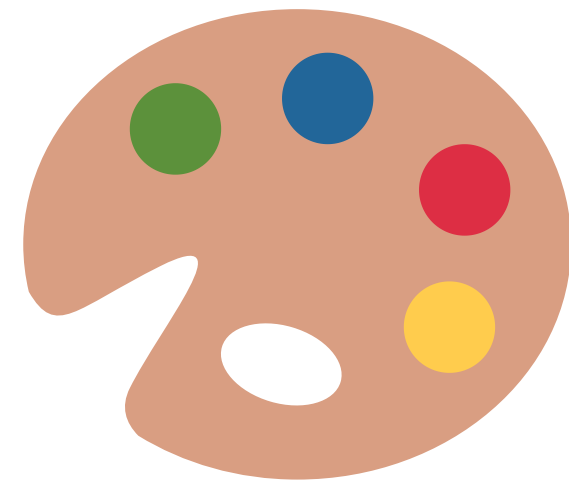

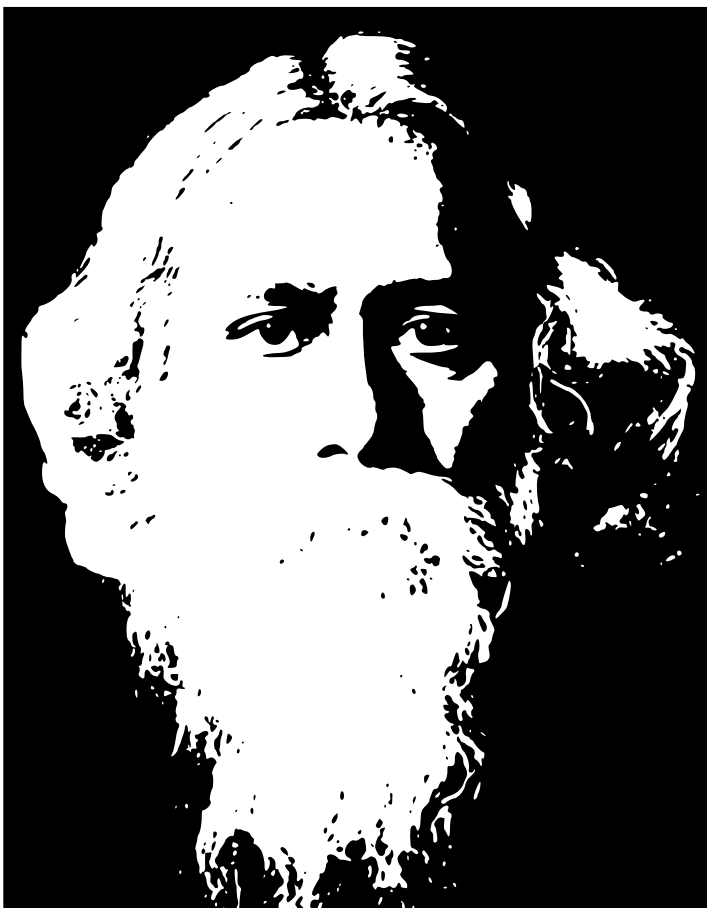

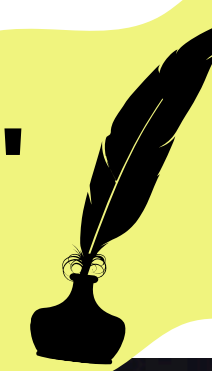

# 'Tagore in Symphony'

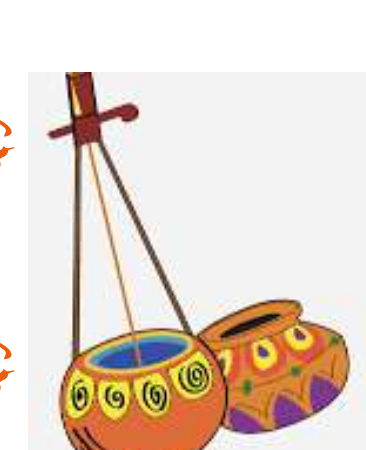
## Std XI Online Orientation

The students celebrated World Book Day by reading books. They also watched a video on the importance of reading and copyright. Each student read a book of their choice in the class and participated in an interactive session on it.



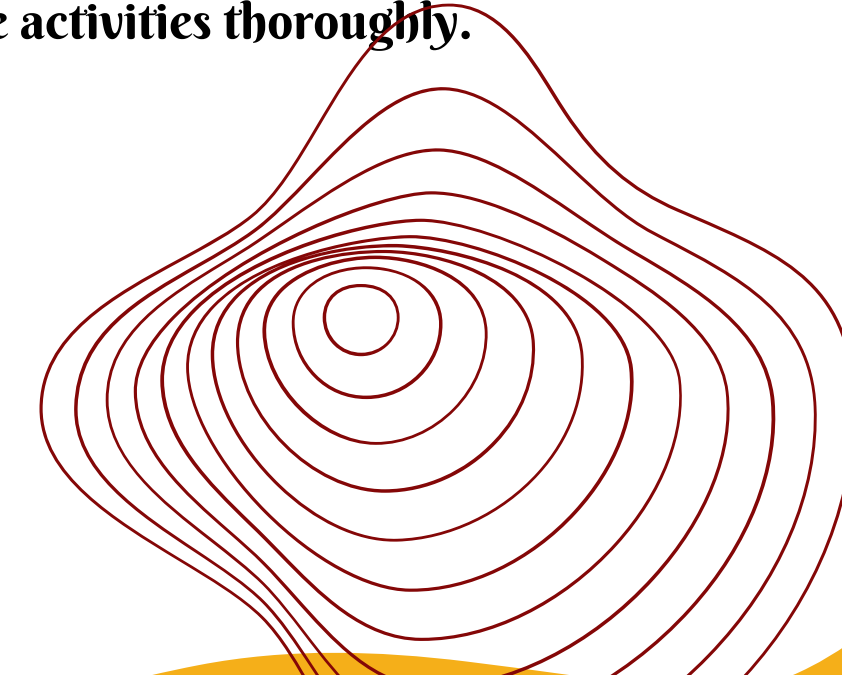
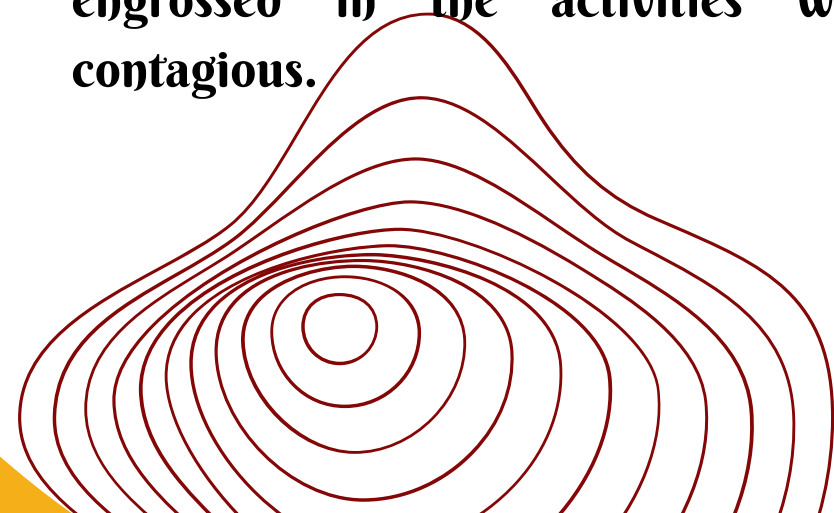
## Book Launch

## Capacity Building Programme 2024 Happy Classroom



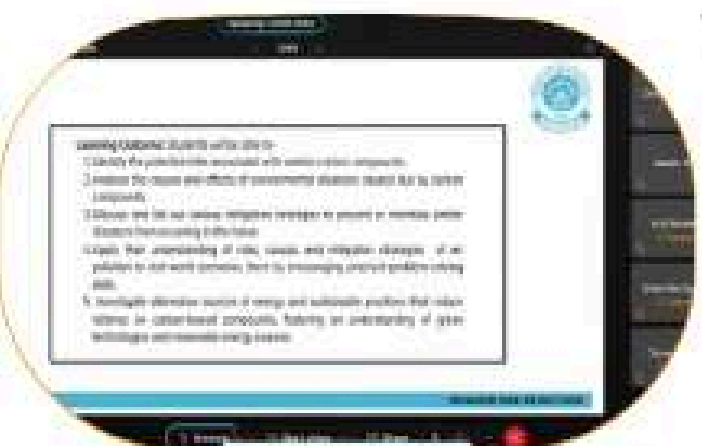
## Happy Classrooms

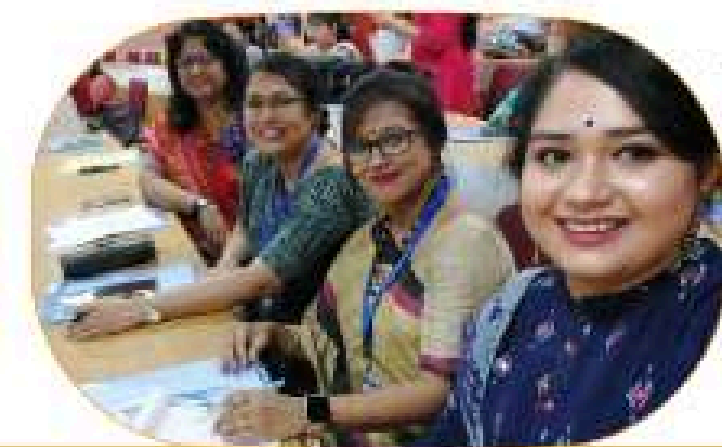
## Career Talk

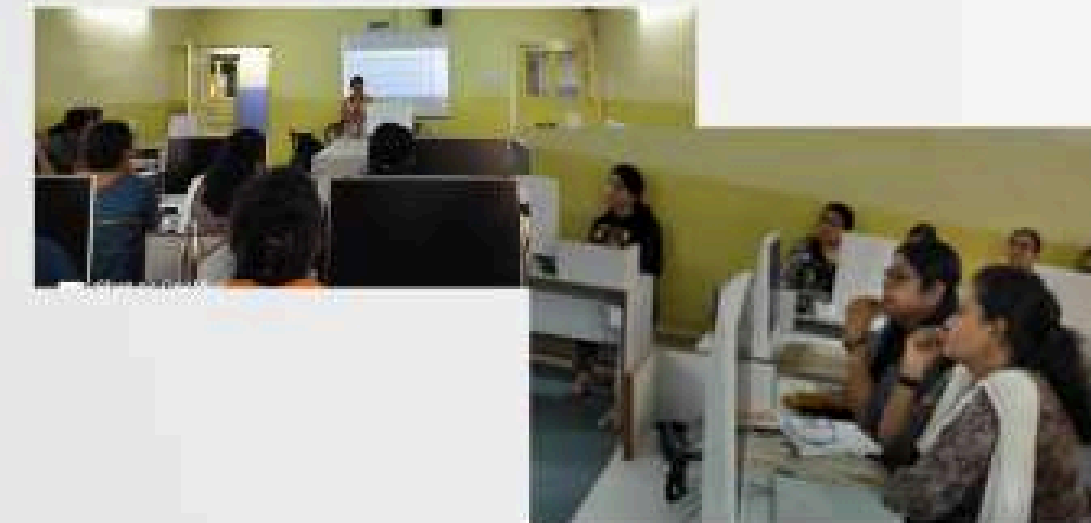


## Macmillan Workshop

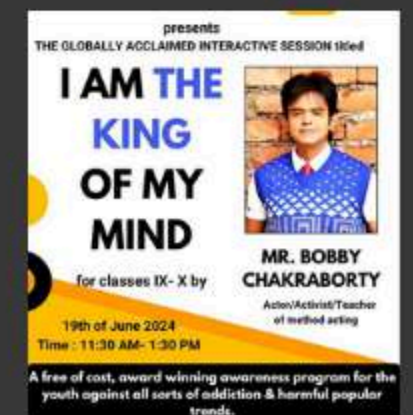


### Retirement Plan National Pension Scheme

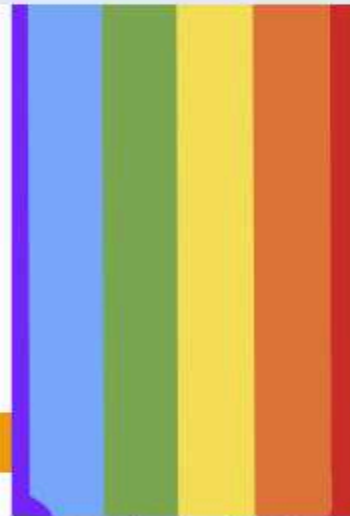
