tivities, managing emotions well and doing well in school. The young adolescents were informed about the red flags that indicated signs of significant changes in our mental health.

Chandra pointed out to the young minds how in today's world of fierce competition, we have completely lost ourselves just to live up to the standards



set by society and that it is perfectly fine to have a bad day, to feel sad or depressed or to be unproductive.

She suggested effective methodologies to the students on how to manage our mental health, building resilience, using technology judiciously, cultivating gratitude and active communication.

The children were taught to readiness, workout, prioritise sleep, eat healthy, start gardening, be creative, listen to music and stay connected with friends and family. At the end of the session the students appreciated and acknowledged that they must heal oneself and help each other, thus enjoying both success and failure.

TEACHERS TAKE OATH TO PROMOTE GENDER EQUALITY



Teachers of BDM International take the pledge

Pledge to rise against discrimination

Calcutta: Teachers of a co-educational school took a pledge on Tuesday they will actively promote gender equality and will power their students to respect and assert their equal rights for all.

The pledge by 100 teachers of BDM International is significant in the aftermath of the rape and murder of the 17-year-old junior doctor at RG Kar Medical College and Hospital on August 5.

"There has to be mutual respect for our abilities and potential capabilities instead of seeing men as more powerful than women," said

Madhusmita Senapati, principal, BDM International. "The teachers pledged, 'we will actively promote gender equality and will power our students to respect and assert their equal rights for all. We promise to guide our students to embrace and uphold the core values of humanity.'"

The discrimination can be subtle or direct, at home or outside. Psychologists and counsellors have spoken time and again about the need to raise boys and girls equally, when they do not perpetrate patriarchal stereotypes.

According to a psycholo-

gist, people's inherent needs to change. "There will be some as vested beings and women as leaders or leaders to them need to change, she said.

Senapati said their school encourages girls and boys equally to participate in sports or sports to common disciplines.

"We have the same shirt and trousers as the uniforms for our students. If we call it uniform, it should be that way. We also advise our teachers to treat them as students, not as girls or boys," she said.

"We, the teachers of BDM International acknow-

ledge to treat all our students with respect, fairness and equality. We will not discriminate against any student based on their gender, race, ethnicity, social or economic status or any other diversity. We will strive to create a safe and inclusive learning environment where all our students feel valued and supported," the teachers pledged to themselves.
