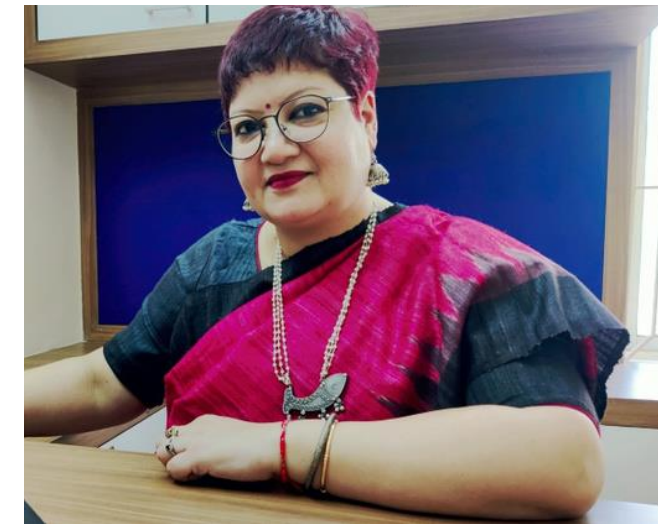

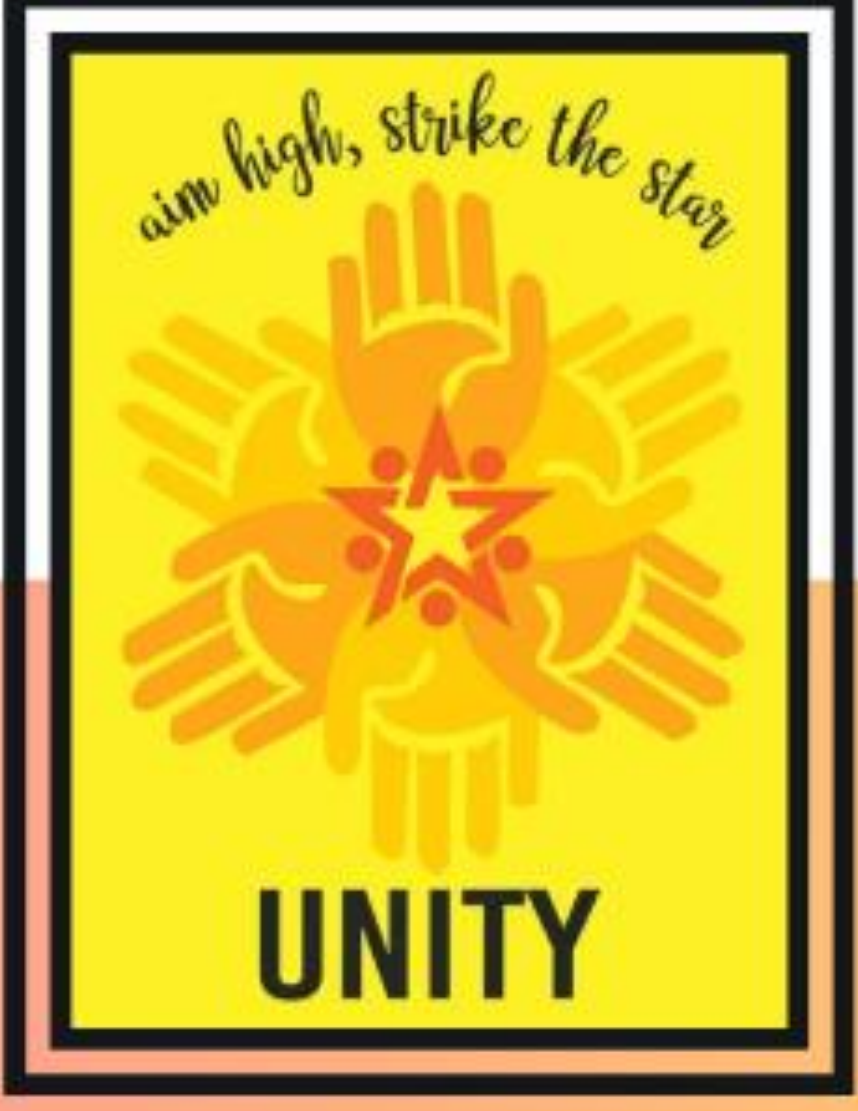

# Things to keep in mind...



Estd. 1966

- *Students must come to school in proper school uniform with tie, belt and ID card regularly.*
- *Shoes should be polished.*
- *Students must come in house uniform on every Tuesdays and Thursdays.*
- *Girls and boys should be in proper hair cut. No hair styling should be done.*
- *Girls having shoulder length hair will make two pony tails and girls having hair below shoulder length should make two plaits.*
- *Only black hairband/ hairpin/ rubber bands are allowed.*
- *Students should cut their nails timely and NO nail paints, mehendi and tattoo are allowed.*
- *Non compliance to school uniform under any unavoidable circumstances should be intimated by the parents through a written application to the class teacher.*



# Things to keep in mind...



Estd. 1966

- *Books and notebooks should be covered and labelled properly with marker pen.*
- *Books to be brought as per time table.*
- *The students should converse in English within the school premises. Speaking in vernacular except during assigned periods is strictly prohibited.*
- *Every student should take proper care of school property. Damaging or destroying any school property is strictly prohibited & may lead to disciplinary action.*
- *Students should refrain from bringing expensive items or other valuables to school. They should take care of their belongings and money should not be lent or borrowed. The school will not be responsible for the goods lost.*



# Things to keep in mind...



Estd. 1966

- *Bicycles must be properly locked and kept in the cycle stand.*
- *School will not be responsible for the security or damage of the vehicles parked outside the school premises.*
- *Students suffering from any contagious disease will not be allowed to attend classes until he or she recovers fully and submits a fitness certificate given by a registered medical practitioner.*
- *Students should actively participate in various co-scholastic activities and community service programmes organized by the school as per the school activity calendar or CBSE Circulars.*
- *All students should bring the school almanac and wear ID cards everyday to school.*



# Things to keep in mind...



Estd. 1966

- *The students are supposed to reach the school 10 minutes before the commencement of the school hours.*
- *The school gate will be closed 10 minutes after the scheduled time and latecomers will not be permitted to enter the school premises.*
- *Visiting clubs, restaurants, shopping malls and theatres in school uniform is strictly forbidden, so is loitering around outside the school after school hours.*
- *Bullying and the use of foul language are punishable offence. Strict disciplinary action will be taken against students indulging in the same.*
- *Bursting of crackers or splashing colours inside the school premises or in school buses is strictly prohibited. No compliance with these instructions may result to strict disciplinary consequences.*



# Things to keep in mind...



Estd. 1966

- Replacement of a school almanac is done on payment of ₹70/- at the school office.
- Replacement of a ID card is done on payment of ₹50/- at the school office.
- The school does not collect any money without a valid receipt.
- Parents are requested to avoid taking their wards during school hours except in the event of an emergency(supported by a valid document).
- No shouting or whistling is allowed in or around the school building. Running in corridors is strictly prohibited. Throwing things outside the window, physically hurting anyone inside the classroom, in the corridors or outside the school, throwing any object at any one is strictly forbidden.
- No gifts should be sent for the teachers of the institution.

- Parents are expected to visit the school website : [www.bdmi.org](http://www.bdmi.org), to get all the necessary information of the school activities. They can also give their feedback through mail ([info@bdmi.org](mailto:info@bdmi.org)) or drop a letter in the “Suggestion Box” kept at the entrance of the respective branches.
- Any important communication from the parent / guardian should be addressed to the Principal through the Class Teacher and all correspondence from the school to the parents will be made by the Principal or Senior Coordinator, keeping the Class Teachers in the loop.
- Parents are requested to provide accurate and correct information while filling up the Statement Pages in the almanac.
- For any alterations in the student record, please submit an application to the Class Teacher along with relevant documents for updation in school records.



- *Parents are to ensure that their ward carry the school almanac regularly to school. Please go through your wards almanac regularly and kindly endorse your signature in the almanac whenever any note is sent to you by the teachers.*
- *Kindly sign the attendance record of your ward (page 58) in the school almanac to keep a track of your ward's regularity in the school. In case of your ward's shortage of attendance, undertaking has to be signed.*
- *Parents are expected to fill up the School Fee Record Page (Pg. No. 30) & School Bus Fee Record Page (Pg. No. 32) in the school almanac.*
- *Parents are requested to encourage their wards to take part in different co-scholastic activities and community service organized by the school and CBSE.*
- *The school discourages parents from taking their wards for a holiday or a long vacation during the school term. If it is unavoidable, prior information has to be given.*



- Remedial classes are taken beyond the school hours and Improvement Tests are conducted.
- We understand that you are happy to allow the school to use the photographs/video clips of your ward for the purpose of publicity, admission, activities & advertisement. In case, you have any reservation, please send an application to the school in this regard.
- It is mandatory for all parents to fill in page no. 3, 4, 5, 6, 27, 30, 32 & 36 of the school almanac.

# Attendance criteria



- *Coming to school regularly is an integral part of student's life. This inculcates discipline and regularity in a student, which in turn create moral values and holistic education is imparted to a child in the school environment.*
- *No student will be allowed to attend the class without a leave application if he / she has been absent the previous day.*
- *Leave taken on medical grounds must be substantiated with a medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner along with an application from the parent.*
- *All students should attend school on the closing and reopening day before and after every vacation.*
- *It is compulsory for all students to maintain regular attendance during the course of the academic session. As per CBSE norms, 75% attendance is mandatory to enable them to appear for the Final Assessment/Board Exam.*
- *Provision of half day leave is not granted, but in an emergency, request can be considered for genuine reasons (substantiated by a valid document). Any type of leave will however be granted through an application from the parent/guardian.*

- *75% attendance is compulsory for the child to be allowed for (Term/Pre Board/Final exams)*

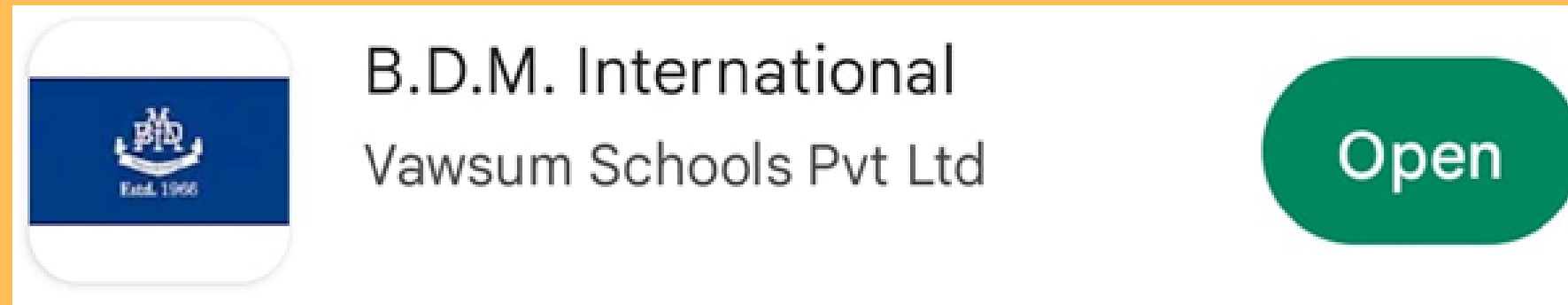
